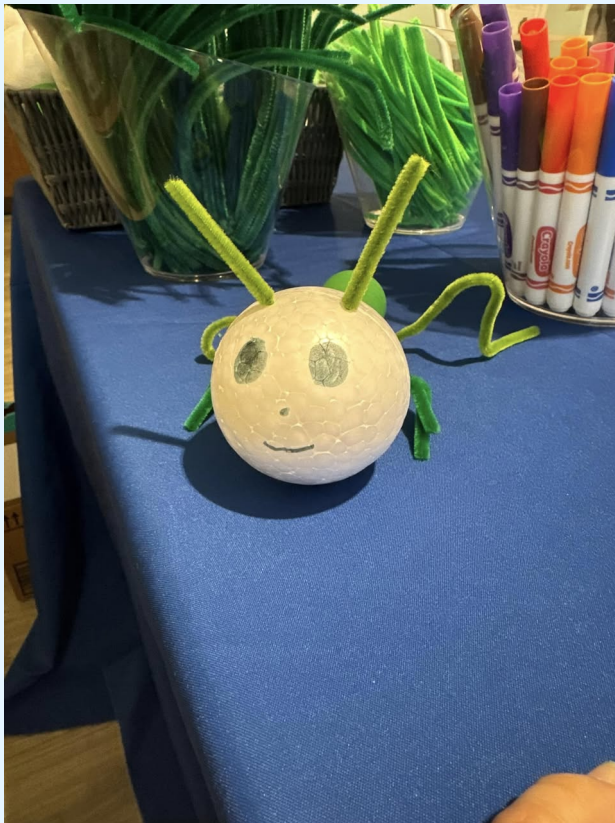
Storybook Village

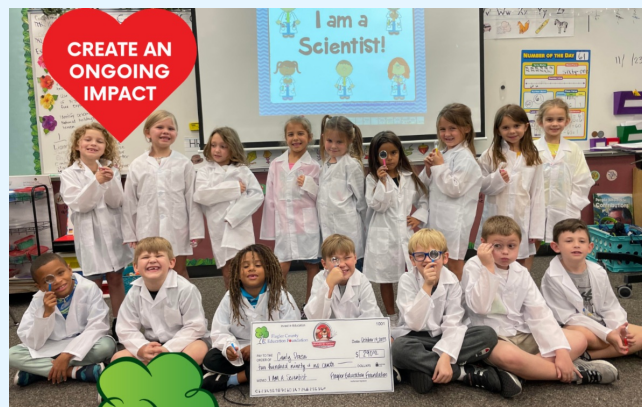
