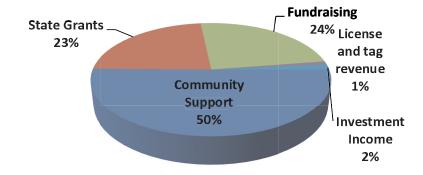
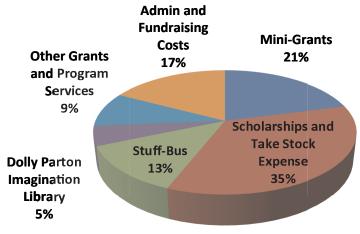


FCEF 2012-2013 Revenues

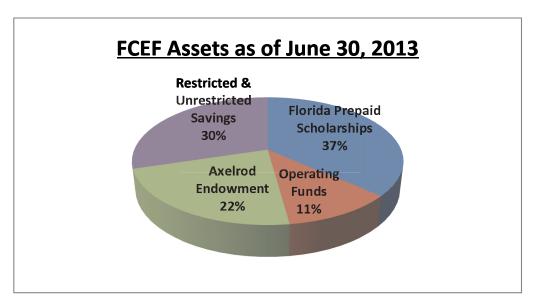

2012-13 Audit Highlights

- The organization's overall combined assets totaled \$910,948 at the close of 2013, compared to \$838,759 one year earlier.
- During 2012, the foundation's combined net position increased by \$259,681 primarily as a result of a one-time \$200,000 endowment contribution and increased community support.
- During 2013, the foundation's combined net position increased by \$80,105 primarily as a result of and unanticipated one-time contribution of \$35,000 and from increased community, corporate and private support.
- In 2013 the foundation hosted a fourth fundraiser (Josh Crews Gala) which generated additional proceeds of \$18,870.
- Administrative costs totaled \$28,676, or 8.6% of operating budget.
- Charitable giving continues to be significantly affected by many factors including the general state of the economy, the health of the stock market and prospective donors' perception of the benefiting organization. The foundation has historically enjoyed a very positive reputation in the communities it serves. While Economic factors ultimately affect charitable giving in general, the foundation has developed a history of steady growth regardless of changes in these factors.
